**NEW RULES**: Entries in the 3ATC – CCC are two tiered this year. The 3 person team event is **ONLY** open to current college students climbing for two years or less. Any competent students climbing more than two years may be entered in to the individually scored Premier level. Each College may enter student teams at one or both locations. Students must be accompanied and supervised by a recognised member of staff.

It is essential that all competitors sign and return a completed entry form and fee to us as soon as possible to receive their entry pack.

Entering this challenge highlights your College's professionalism and ability to train staff for the UK arboricultural industry it's also competitive and educational but remember it's supposed to be fun and educational for all climbers taking part. Please encourage and respect your fellow climbers, one day you may be working together.

Once you have booked in your team we will include your colleges name in our competitor listings on the 3ATC website. Following the event we reserve the right to use your image in any publicity or promotional material we may produce including photographs on our website. Photographs and editorial may also be appearing in the trade press.
