

Senior Craftsman Tree Worker

Job Role

A senior craftsman tree worker will undertake advanced technical tasks. They will lead a range of tree work jobs and supervise colleagues. They are capable of directing multiple tree work teams across a range of technical skills. They are able to liaise directly with the client to include specifying and quoting for tree work.

Job Description

- 1 Consistently ensures that they and others keep appointments or agreed start times and that appropriate clothing, suitable for the work place is worn.
- 2 Ensures that the designated PPE for the work place is worn by everyone
- 3 Responsible for ensuring the loading and unloading of the works vehicle prior to departure to and from site
- 4 Giving instructions to work colleagues to include signing onto the emergency action plan & risk assessment
- 5 Completes a site specific risk assessment and communicates it to work colleagues
- 6 Setting out and organises the site effectively to include disposal of arisings (?)
- 7 Assigns tasks to individual team members according to their competency
- 8 Works to a specification issued by the client/employer
- 9 Directing the planting of tree stock
- 10 Specifying and supervising the setting out of work place signage (highway & non highway)
- 11 Allocates traffic management roles
- 12 Ensures that the site clear up is to the required standard
- 13 Protecting and avoiding damage to customer property
- 14 Identifies H&S issues onsite and ensures a safe system of work is in place
- 15 Takes appropriate care of tools & equipment to include action to report or rectify faults
- 16 Ensures that team/crew works effectively together
- 17 Fells and processes a range of tree sizes, selecting the appropriate assisted fell technique
- 18 Supports aerial tree workers (MEWP & Climbing) with the selection and transfer of equipment for aerial tree work operations
- 19 Supervises a range of aerial based pruning operations with hand tools and chainsaws

- 20 Recognises a wider range of shrub and tree species using common names
- 21 Recognises a wider range of structural and decay based tree defects
- 22 Works safely at height in the tree undertaking a range of pruning operations using free fall and rigging techniques either from a rope and harness or a MEWP
- 23 Carries out dismantling operations using free fall techniques and basic rigging operations either from a rope and harness or a MEWP
- 24 Fells standing stems following partial or complete removal of the crown
- 25 Completes vehicle and machinery records and maintenance logs
- 26 Recognises a basic range of common tree related pests and diseases
- 27 Communicates effectively with the public, clients and/or the employer
