

# Forestry workers: what should you have on your feet?

As a forestry worker, you will usually spend 37 hours on your feet, Monday to Friday, maybe more.

You have a physically demanding job, working outdoors facing all weather, using power tools and heavy machinery, working in one of the most dangerous sectors in the UK.

Prioritising safety and recognising the hazards, both on and above ground, is crucial. Better to be safe than sorry.

## What safety classification do you need?

### S3

Best suited in the Utility Arb market where underfoot protection is required

*Steel toe protection against a 200-joule impact*  
*Antistatic protection*  
*Resistant to fuel oil and energy absorption in the heel*  
*Prevents water penetration and absorption of the upper*  
*Puncture resistant steel midsole*

### SB

Best suited in the Arborist market where flexibility and manoeuvrability are important

*Steel toe protection against a 200-joule impact*
